

Step one:

Unzip the ZIP file and install the font "shiDevaSk.ttf" into the "WINDOWS\Fonts" folder.

Step two:

#### Installing Indic Support for Windows XP

Follow these steps to install Indic Support:

1. Start Button -> Settings -> Control Panel.
2. Double Click on Regional Options.
3. Select Languages
4. Click "Details"
5. Click "Add"
6. Select "Hindi"
7. Click OK.

Step three:

Before you can use Hindi and other Indic languages in Office XP applications (including Word XP) you would need to add the respective language support via Office XP Language settings. You can do this by following steps:

1. Run Programs -> Microsoft Office Tools -> Microsoft Office XP Language Settings.
2. Add Hindi (or Tamil etc.) to Enabled Languages.

Step four

1. Select "Hi" (Hindi) at the Taskbar
2. Run Word XP (or WordPad, Editor etc.)
3. Select "shiDeva"
4. Now you may type in Devanagari Characters
